Q3 2020

Key Highlights

The top subsector stock performer in Q3 2020 was digital educational content & services, up 32.4% year-over-year

On average, EBITDA multiples for the subsectors increased 0.3x from the prior quarter and decreased 1.3x on a year-over-year basis

Q3 2020 Education Update

The third quarter of the year, and the second "COVID" quarter, unfolded largely as we expected. Closed transaction volumes remained slower than prior year and pre-COVID levels, but signs of increasing activity were demonstrable. The volume and pace of discussions amongst both entrepreneur-owned and institutionally-backed businesses increased markedly. Despite continued uncertainty around the impact of COVID on primary, secondary and post-secondary schools across the U.S. and globally, interest levels amongst investors in education assets, and particularly ed tech assets, has not dissipated. If anything, investors have become even more aggressive seeking recurring revenue-driven businesses with recession- and COVID-resistant products.

As we enter the fourth quarter, we are already seeing and expect to see continued strong deal activity across the market. A number of ed tech businesses that have benefitted greatly from the shift to remote learning and assessment are expected to transact before year end. The sale of ExamSoft to Turnitin was recently announced and represents the first of what will be a small wave of larger middle market transactions in this category. Though we expect future transaction sizes to fall off somewhat, this trend will carry into 2021 as investors continue to be hyper-aggressive in competitive auction processes. Similarly, we expect strong 2020 performance from many SaaS providers in the education market to drive another wave of transaction activity in 2021 as the market continues to consolidate around a handful of private equity-backed platforms.

While the spread of COVID and related economic shutdowns paused a significant amount of activity briefly, overall 2020 market performance is now expected to be much closer to 2019 levels than forecasted as recently as June, and 2021 activity is poised to comfortably surpass 2020 levels.







Quarter-over-Quarter Price Performance




Quarter-over-Quarter Stock Indices Price Change
